Questions that must be answered on this site are: What is an Educational Technologist and Instructional Designer? What is eLearning? It cannot be assumed that everyone's definitions are consistent.

**Problem, Need or Opportunity**: This website will help boost business by creating a professional online presence and brand. It will also alleviate the problem of demonstrating work samples during interviews by showcasing my work samples in an online portfolio. In addition, it will help with my application to the Masters in EDTEC program and is a repository for my EDTEC 541 Assignments. Multimedia is appropriate as I am an eLearning designer/developer and my work samples contain images, audio, video, animation and interactivity such as navigational interfaces, quizzes and games.

### **Audience**

Clients

EDTEC e-portfolio

The website must also meet the requirements of the Educational Technology Masters e-Portfolio Rubric below:

Personal Introduction Page (10%) – Evaluates both the appearance and the quality of the page. This is your opening screen so first impressions in layout and content are important.

Standards Matrix (10%) – Each artifact will be included in a standards matrix to provide a simple overview of which standards it addresses.

Artifacts and Reflections (35%) – Individual pages will be completed for each of the artifacts included in the portfolio. These reflections will have been completed in the courses where the artifacts were originally created.

Comprehensive Reflection Page (20%) – This reflection covers the students' experience throughout their program.

Usability (20%) – The e-portfolio itself will demonstrate good verbal and visual literacy, and appropriate use of principles of readability, page layout, and navigation.

Overall Quality (5%) – A small part of the assessment is included to allow evaluators the latitude to reward exceptional work that exceeds the expectations included in the rest of the rubric.

EDTEC students & faculty:

Feedback from students and faculty are taken into account. Students and faculty were simply asked what they would like to see on an EDTEC Masters Program candidate's website.

### **Environment**

The user will most likely be accessing the site through their home or business computer. Since the site contains multimedia, the user will need a high-speed Internet connection and Flash player to view the content. If they are unwilling to update their technology to be able to view the content, they should not be considering eLearning solutions for their training needs.

## **Resources and Limitations**

The resources for my website are all currently available and owned by me. Therefore copyright permissions will not be necessary. The template is a free open-source template. As the designer of the eLearning samples, I reserve the right to take credit for and showcase my work.
